A few highlights:

- The Share Your Faith Team handed out tracts and received several prayer requests. They were also able to encourage believers in their faith and evangelism efforts.
- People loved dancing under the pavilion, as well as cuddling with the baby goats!
- We were blessed to serve:
 - 480 Walking Tacos
 - 18 crock pots of chili
 - 15 gallons of cider
 - 360 cups of hot chocolate
 - 544 hot dogs
 - 373 boxes of popcorn
 - 336 bags chips
 - 526 smores
- The congregation provided a great selection of cupcakes, cookies, muffins, and breads - thank you so much!
- There were 82 people who signed up to serve, with many, many more who showed up to help set up, break down tents and tables, and clean up the bathrooms and kitchen

"For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God" (1 Cor. 1:18). The death of Christ stands at the center of the Christian faith. Indeed, there is no forgiveness of sins and assurance of eternal life apart from the historical reality of Jesus' execution on a Roman cross two thousand years ago.


Mission to the World 30 Days of Prayer

- FRIDAY: November 7 - Pray for the 2024 PC(USA) Commission, that God would use the commission's passion for the Great Commission.
- SATURDAY: November 8 - Pray for church planters who are writing the future of their local and future people of India.
- SUNDAY: November 9 - Pray for persecuted Christians in Belarus, Ukraine, and Russia.
- MONDAY: November 10 - Pray for MTW's members who are caring for their families and helping them help others in their communities.
- TUESDAY: November 11 - Pray for new churches in Mexico, Philippines, and India.
- WEDNESDAY: November 12 - Pray for the church in Brazil, that God would use the church to also care well.
- THURSDAY: November 13 - Pray for new church planters in Mexico, Philippines, and India.
- FRIDAY: November 14 - Pray for the Lord to renew Turkey, continuing to rebuild from last year's devastating earthquake. Pray for the spiritual growth of the open-hall groups seen as a result.
- SATURDAY: November 15 - Pray for God to move the "new generation" of church leaders to take the lead in local and regional church planting.
- SUNDAY: November 16 - Pray for the church in Uganda. Pray they would make the most of their connections with the present.
- MONDAY: November 17 - Pray that growing networks of believers around the world would thrive.
- TUESDAY: November 18 - Pray for the mission in the "sheerback" of Indonesia. Pray that all the groups in the area, including Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal communities.
