2024 Operation Christmas Child Wrap-Up

A big thank you to everyone who participated in this year's Operation Christmas Child efforts!



National Collection Week was a great success thanks to our many volunteers (78 this week alone!) and everyone who contributed shoeboxes and items throughout the year for our packing party. We had tremendous generosity in giving this year. Many children and their families will be blessed through these shoebox gifts that will be presented with the gospel message attached in their own language.

A total of **8,921** boxes were received from the local community at our drop-off site, an increase of **547** boxes over last year!

Our congregation contributed a total of **426** boxes, which includes **310** boxes packed at the packing party from donations collected throughout the year. In addition, one business of a Covenant family contributed another **244** boxes. The four tractor trailers once in the parking lot are totally full, and **22** additional cartons of shoeboxes & filler items will be transported by individuals serving at the Baltimore, MD processing center. **21,364** children will receive boxes from our location, **745** more than last year. Praise God!
