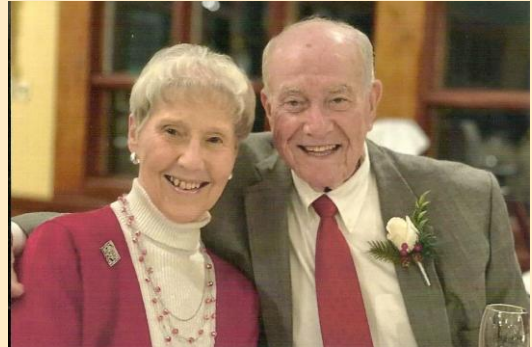




Congregation Connection
