ACTS 16:13-14, 16:25-26, 16:30-32

LEARN THE WORD

Colossians 2:6-7

Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

- On the second missionary journey, Paul and Silas shared the Gospel in Philippi. The Lord opened the heart of a woman named Lydia, and she believed.
- When Paul and Silas were thrown into prison, they praised God. Then after an earthquake freed all the prisoners, the jailer asked how he could be saved. Paul and Silas shared the Gospel with the jailer and his family, and they believed.

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What did Paul and Silas share with Lydia and the other women?

Answer: *The Gospel of Jesus.*

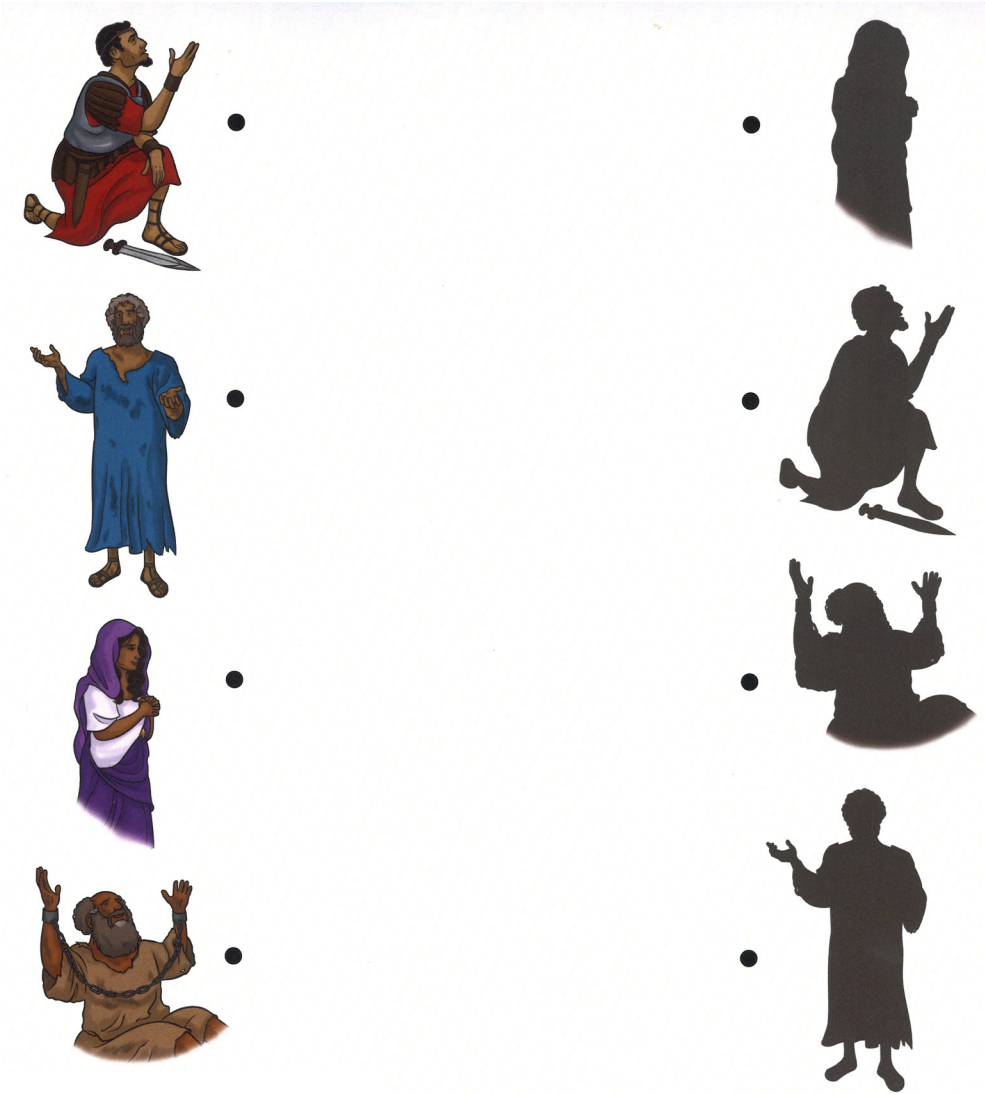
2. What were Paul and Silas doing while they were in prison?

Answer: *Singing and praying to God.*

3. Who did Paul say the jailer must believe in to be saved from sin?

Answer: *The Lord Jesus.*

Activity: Draw a line to match the shadows with the people from our lesson. Do you remember who they were and what they did?



Answers: Jailor—asked how to be saved; Silas—traveled with Paul; Lydia—listened and believed; Paul—shared the Gospel and praised God even in prison.
