

LEARN THE WORD

Colossians 2:6-7

Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

- Paul wrote to the Thessalonians to encourage them to continue living faithfully as they waited for Jesus' second coming.
- Paul corrected those who were being lazy busybodies and told them to do their work. He also encouraged all the believers to not grow tired of doing good.

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. Paul encouraged Christians to keep doing what is good until who comes back?

 Answer: Jesus.
- 2. At Jesus' second coming, believers will meet Him in the air. How long will they be with Him in heaven?

Answer: Always. Forever.

3. What was the problem Paul had to correct in his second letter to the Thessalonians: laziness, anger, or cheating?

Answer: Laziness.
