WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. Paul told the Corinthian believers that they should work together. He wanted them to work in: unity or disunity?

Answer: Unity.

- 2. What word picture did Paul use for the church that has many parts working together? *Answer:* The body.
- 3. Why should all believers do their part to help each other? What would happen if a part is missing?

Answer: The church cannot do what it needs to do if there is a part missing.

Activity: Paul used the word picture of a body to explain that believers are all part of the body of Christ. Follow the path over and under to match the hands, feet, and eyes.
