LEARN THE WORD

Colossians 2:6-7

Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. All people are created by God in His image, but only those who repent by turning from their sins and trust in Jesus become what?

Answer: *Children of God.*

2. When God adopts someone into His family, what can that person call Him?

Answer: *Abba, Father.*

3. God promises each of His children an inheritance that will never wear out, has no sin in it, and will always be beautiful. Where is this inheritance?

Answer: *In heaven.*
