ACTS 27 (SELECTED VERSES), 28:3-6, 28:16

LEARN THE WORD

Colossians 2:6-7

Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

- On the way to Rome, God kept Paul safe through a terrible storm, a shipwreck, and a poisonous snakebite.
- While in Rome, Paul was allowed to live in a house where he could have visitors. He shared the Gospel with everyone who visited, and he wrote letters and sent messages to other believers.

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What terrible things happened to Paul on the way to Rome?

Answer: *A terrible storm, a shipwreck, and a poisonous snake bit him.*

2. Who kept His promise and protected Paul all the way to Rome?

Answer: *God.*

3. What word means God is in control of everything?

Answer: *Sovereign.*

Activity: God protected Paul through a storm, a shipwreck, and a snakebite! He kept His promise to bring Paul to Rome. Use the number code to color the picture then tell someone about Paul's exciting journey.
