WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What did Jesus come to save us from: the Romans or our sins?

Answer: *Our sins.*

2. When Jesus rode into town onto a donkey, what word did the people shout, which means "save now"?

Answer: *Hosanna!*

3. Because Jesus died and paid the punishment for our sins, who can we come to and ask to forgive us?

Answer: *God.*
