LEARN THE WORD

Genesis 12:1-2

Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing."

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD **FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION**

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What kinds of things did God bless Job with?

Answer: *Oxen, donkeys, sheep, camels, servants, and children.*

2. What kinds of bad things happened to Job?

Answer: *Servants and children killed; oxen, donkeys, and camels stolen; fire from the sky killed the sheep; Job had sores all over.*

3. What did Job do when these things happened?

Answer: *He prayed and worshiped God.*

Activity: Job trusted God even when bad things happened. Draw a line to all the pictures that remind us who is in control.
