LEARN THE WORD

Exodus 20:1-3

And God spoke all these words, saying, "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. You shall have no other gods before me."

- God gave the Ten Commandments to teach the Israelites (and us) how they should treat Him and each other.
- Because none of us can keep the Ten Commandments perfectly, these commands also show us our sin and need for a Savior—Jesus.

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- Who should we honor with our words and put first in our lives? (Think about the first and third commandments.)

Answer: God.

- Who else should we honor by obeying them? (It's the fifth commandment.)

Answer: Honor our parents.

- The ninth commandment says we should not lie. What should we do instead?

Answer: Tell the truth.

Activity: Ten Commandments. God gave the Ten Commandments, which are important for all of us. Trace the number around each picture. Can you remember what each commandment means?
