JOSHUA 1:5-6, 1:9, 2:11

LEARN THE WORD

Joshua 1:9

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

- God chose Joshua to lead the Israelites after Moses' death and promised to help Joshua.
- Joshua sent spies into Jericho where a woman named Rahab hid them and helped them escape because she had faith in God.

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What did God tell Joshua to be?

Answer: *Strong and courageous.*

2. What did Rahab believe about God?

Answer: *He is the one true God.*

3. Where did Rahab hide the spies?

Answer: *She hid them on her roof underneath the flax.*
