



ISRAEL TURNS TO IDOLS

JUDGES 2:14-16, 3:7-9

LEARN THE WORD

Joshua 1:9

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

- For about 300 years, Israel repeated a cycle of idol worship and disobeying God.
- Whenever we make anything more important than God, it can become an idol.

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What did the Israelites do that started a cycle of sin?

Answer: *Worshiped false gods/idols.*

2. What did God do when the Israelites cried out for help?

Answer: *He chose a judge to lead and fight for them.*

3. What kinds of things can be idols to us today?

Answer: *Toys, sports, TV/movie watching, new clothes, new tech devices, etc.*

Activity: God often blesses us with many things. But we must not let them turn into idols. Draw a line to match the pictures then color them.
