FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What did Samson fight and kill with his bare hands?

Answer: *A lion.*

2. Who wanted to know the secret to Samson's strength?

Answer: *Delilah. The Philistines who would pay her if she found out.*

3. How did Samson win his last fight with the Philistines?

Answer: *He prayed for strength and pushed on the pillars that held up the building they were in. It fell down and killed thousands of Philistines.*
