LEARN THE WORD

1 John 1:8-9

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What kinds of things did Jonathan do that showed he was a true friend to David?

Answer: *He gave David gifts because he was okay with David being the next king; he talked to his father about David; he gave David the message to run away.*

2. What did Saul do with his spear?

Answer: *Threw it at David and then at Jonathan.*

3. How did Jonathan get the message to David that he was in danger?

Answer: *He went to the field where David was hiding. When he shot his arrow, whatever he told the boy to do, was a message for David.*
