WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What was the temple for?

Answer: *It was a place for people to worship God and offer sacrifices.*

2. Name some things used to build the temple.

Answer: *Gold, silver, cedar wood, gem stones.*

3. What did the Lord fill the temple with to show He was pleased with it?

Answer: *A cloud.*
