LESSON 41

- 1. Rebekah had twin boys. What were their names? Answer: Esau and Jacob.
- 2. What did God tell Rebekah about her children? Which one would be the leader? Answer: The older would serve the younger. Jacob.
- What word means that the firstborn son received a double portion of his parents' wealth and got to be in charge when his father died? Answer: Birthright.
- What did Esau want from Jacob when he returned from hunting all day and was tired and hungry? Answer: Lentil stew.
- 5. What did Jacob ask Esau to trade for some stew? Answer: His birthright.

LESSON 42

- 6. What did Isaac ask Esau to do before he would give him the blessing? Answer: Go hunting and prepare him a meal.
- 7. What did Rebekah want Jacob to do to get the blessing? Answer: Trick Isaac.
- 8. Name one thing Rebekah and Jacob did to trick Isaac into thinking Jacob was Esau. Answer: They put goat skins on Jacob's hands and neck so he would feel hairy. They prepared Isaac's favorite meal. Jacob wore Esau's clothes.
- 9. How did Esau feel when he found out that Jacob stole his blessing? Answer: Angry. He wanted to kill Jacob.
- 10. Because Esau was so angry, where did Rebekah tell Jacob to flee? Answer: To her brother Laban.

- **12.** How did Laban trick Jacob? Answer: He gave him Leah instead of Rachel to marry.

- 14. How many sons did Jacob have in all? Answer: 12.

- 15. What is the word that means to make two people become friends again after an argument or disagreement? Answer: Reconcile.
- 16. How did Jacob feel when he heard Esau was coming with 400 men? Answer: Afraid. Very worried.
- 17. Who came to Jacob at night and wrestled with him? Answer: God. Jesus.
- 18. After God blessed Jacob, what new name did He give Jacob? Answer: Israel.
- 19. How did Esau greet Jacob? Answer: He hugged him, forgave him, and cried with him.

- 20. What did Jacob give to Joseph that made his brothers jealous? Answer: A multi-colored coat.
- 21. How did Joseph's brothers feel after they heard his dreams about them bowing to him? *Answer: Jealous and angry. They hated him.*

- **23.** Why did the brothers dip the colored coat in goat's blood? *Answer: So it would look like a wild animal killed Joseph. To trick their father into thinking Joseph was dead.*
- 24. What word describes how God was in control of everything that happened to Joseph? *Answer: Sovereign.*

- 25. Who bought Joseph as a slave in Egypt and made him overseer of his household? Answer: Potiphar.
- **26.** How did Joseph end up in prison? Answer: Potiphar's wife lied and said that he attacked her.
- 27. What two important officials of Pharaoh had dreams in prison? Answer: Chief cupbearer and baker.
- 28. What did Joseph do for the baker and cupbearer? Answer: Told them what their dreams meant.
- 29. Which official was given his job back and which one was put to death by Pharaoh, just as Joseph said? Answer: The cupbearer got his job back, and the baker was killed.

- **36. What did Joseph accuse his brothers of being?** Answer: Spies.
- **37. What did the brothers have to do to get Simeon out of prison?** Answer: Bring Benjamin back with them.
- 38. What did Joseph tell his servant to put into Benjamin's sack? Answer: Joseph's silver cup.
- **39.** Why did Joseph make it look like Benjamin stole the cup and say he would be his slave? *Answer:* To see if his brothers had changed and would protect Benjamin.
- **40. Why were the brothers afraid when Joseph said who he was?** Answer: They thought he would want revenge for what they did to him.
- 41. Joseph's brothers meant evil against him, but what good did God cause to come from Joseph's slavery in Egypt? Answer: Joseph became the ruler who prepared for the famine and saved many people, including his own family.

- **46.** How was Joseph blessed? Answer: He would have many descendants.
- **47. Why did the new king of Egypt make the Israelites slaves?** *Answer: He was afraid of them because there were more of them than there were Egyptians. They might fight against the Egyptians.*
