OPENING DISCUSSION

3. Looking at verse 37, what does it mean to be a conqueror through Christ? How does the love of God impact this?

1. What encouragement do you personally take from this passage? What comfort does it give to you as a believer?
2. What does it mean that Jesus is interceding for you? How does this speak to His relationship with you?
3. How can you better understand and know the love of God? How do we portray that to others?
