Hebrews 10:19-25

GROUP DISCUSSION

OPENING DISCUSSION

Read Hebrews 10:19-25 as a group and pray together. Reflecting on the sermon this past week, what surprised you, stood out to you, or was new to you? Did anything specifically convict you?

FROM THE MESSAGE

1. Describe the meaning of the grammatical terms “indicative” and “imperative.” Why is this so helpful to know as we read and meditate on Scripture? What are the indicatives and imperatives in this text?
2. How did God complete the work of salvation in Christ? How would you describe that to someone that you are evangelizing to? What does it mean to be perfected in Christ? Does this mean that we ourselves are perfect?
3. What does it mean to have confidence in Christ? What gives us this confidence? Is it something within us, or something external to us?
4. Describe the role of Jesus as our high priest. What bearing and impact does that have on our life and our relationship with God?

FOR OUR LIVES

1. What is the relationship between the imperatives of Scripture and our actions? Why is obedience so important in the life of a believer?
2. How are you drawing near to Christ in faith? What tangible things are you doing to build your relationship with the Lord Jesus?
3. What does it mean for us to hold fast in hope? What does that look like in the life of a believer?
4. How are you stirring up others toward love and good works? Would others in your life affirm that you act on this imperative in Scripture?
