## **GROUP DISCUSSION**

## **OPENING DISCUSSION**

Read John 6:34-35 as a group and pray together. Reflecting on the sermon this past week, what surprised you, stood out to you, or was new to you? Did anything specifically convict you?

### FROM THE MESSAGE

- 1. "I am the bread of life" What does this statement describe about Jesus? How does it inform us about who He is?
- 2. "Shall not hunger and never thirst" What is the spiritual meaning that this metaphor is describing? From the message points, what two truths does it convey to us?
- *3. "Whoever and whoever"* Describe the nature of the invitation that Christ presents here. Is this invite for everyone? How long does it last?
- 4. "Comes to me and believes in me" What actions does this invitation require of us? What is the importance of trust in our relationship with Christ? Is it one-time or continual?

### FOR OUR LIVES

- 1. How are you filling yourself with the bread of life? What practical steps can you take to do this?
- 2. Who in your life can you present Christ's invitation to? Who needs to hear about Christ from you?
- 3. How can we continue to trust Christ with our lives?
