### **OPENING DISCUSSION**

4. What does it mean to love Jesus? How does that love show you belong to God?

1. As Pastor Rob challenged us at the beginning of his sermon, does God's Word find a place in you? Who's your source of knowledge?
2. Do you do what God says on a regular basis? Where do you need to grow in doing what He says?
3. Who from Scripture is someone you seek to emulate? Who is someone godly in your life that you look up to? If you don't have someone, who would be a good person to begin with?
4. Does your life show a love for Jesus? If so, how? If not, why not?
