### TITLE

Baptism

## GROUP DISCUSSION

### OPENING DISCUSSION

Read Romans 6:3-4 and 1 Peter 3:21 as a group and pray together. Reflecting on the sermon this past week, what surprised you, stood out to you, or was new to you? Did anything specifically convict you?

### FROM THE MESSAGE

1. How are we baptized into Jesus' death? Is it through the waters of baptism (*Answer: No!*)?
2. What is the result of being baptized into His death? How does our baptism by immersion symbolize this death to sin and life in Christ?
3. How does baptism symbolize our deliverance from judgment? What picture does 1 Peter 3:21 use to show this salvation?

### FOR OUR LIVES

1. Take time as a group to share some of your testimonies and/or baptism stories. Encourage each other by sharing of how you came to Christ or your expression of it through baptism.
2. Those who were baptized were asked what God has been doing in their lives since the moment of their salvation. What work of God has been evident in your life since your salvation?
3. Baptism is an amazing reminder of the work God has done in all of our lives. How else can you remind yourself regularly of the work God is doing in your life and the lives of others?
4. If you have not been baptized as a believer, how did this Sunday encourage you to take that next step in your faith? Is there anything that is holding you back from baptism?
