Truly, this has been the climax of the entire year's work and prayer, moreover since 2020 when we landed here in Budapest! On December 17, **we had our first Sunday morning church service** for Zugló Bible Church in our new building. The service was wonderful. We had 18 people, many of which were first-time guests. It was a combination of lost people and those that we had personally led to the Lord! The feedback afterwards was good. We were glad to hear that many of the guests really enjoyed the service, and I think many of them will return.

Please pray for 2024 for our new church! There are new believers who will need baptized. There are believers who will begin discipleship. The gospel will need to be preached to the lost. New believers need trained in the basics of the Bible and what it means to be a Christian. We are praying for all of this to happen, and for God's vision to accomplish it all.

Also, I would say around 30-40% of the square footage of our building needs renovated, and could then be used for children's rooms, an office, storage, and more. Our landlord agreed to pay for half of the expenses of the renovation (in our contract), but since this is a leased building, I want to make sure that we will plan to be here for the foreseeable future before investing a significant amount of funds in it. I'll be praying about this in the first quarter of the year.

Thank you all for your continued, faithful prayers and support. What a testament this church service is to the faithfulness of God to hear and answer the prayers of His saints. Thanks to YOU for your part in this work. We are so excited for what God has in store for our church in 2024!

What an awesome event — to celebrate **our 20th Anniversary of Mongolian Missions** with the launch of our first national missions training module in our *newly heated* dorms, chapel and cafeteria! One Mongolian pastor came all the way from the Gobi desert to attend the training sessions. Another church planter, Zoloo, has been laboring alone in a remote region northwest of us for over 15 years. He and his friend, Saihnaa, spent 20 hours of grueling travel, digging his van out of muddy riverbed roads to get to the training. These are the kind of men we want to help equip and encourage who have the calling of God and grit to go to the hardest to reach uttermost places.

We're equally excited about our church's new plant that is beginning to bud in a small unreached town southwest of us. Last night, Pastor Migaa preached on John 3:16 and at the end of the service, one lady stood up and enthusiastically said, "Let's believe!" That spontaneous proclamation brought back memories of the first group that met in our tent 20 years earlier. I'll never forget when a brand new believer testified with that same sincerity, "We were blind, but now we see!"

This is what it's all about. God called, you sent and together we are striving to remain faithful for them and every other soul who will come to know Jesus in this faraway land. Trina and I want to publicly thank the Lord and all of our faithful partners in the gospel for the best and most impactful 20 years of our lives.

We are using a gospel film in their own language, our tract ministry and a radio ministry. We are seeing the Lord not only watching over His word but also performing it.

There have been 59 people saved since Brother Wayne Anderson was there in September. God has been good to Maya Missions and we give Him all the praise and glory for His blessings to us.

Please continue to pray for our operation under current government. The Belize government finally approved our BCCAR papers which allows us to work in Belize. We praise the Lord for this approval. We are having a lot of problems with this government and getting our Guatemalan pastors across the border for Pastors School. Without going into too much detail — so you will know how to pray — the immigration department has refused to stamp our pastors passports, which creates a big problem. We ask for your prayers (and fasting, if the Lord leads you that way).
