- 1. Do you think more about other people's opinions of you than what others think about God?
- 2. Is your mind more preoccupied with cultural, political, and social issues than kingdom issues?
- 3. Are your emotions more stirred when talking about cultural, political, and social issues than talking about Jesus?
- 4. Does the focus of your finances reflect love for personal comfort more than for the Kingdom of God?
- 5. Do you frequently long for positions, possessions, or pleasures that you do not have?
- 6. Are your ambitions in life to promote yourself more than to promote Jesus?
- 7. Are you preoccupied with getting rather than giving?
- 8. Are your desires for your children primarily focused on material wealth, achievement, and personal comfort or on knowing and following Jesus?
- 9. Do you use your status, wealth, or possessions to impress others or to influence others for Jesus?

- 10. Do you pursue worldly goals more than you pursue intimacy with Jesus?
- 11. How much do you consider God and His Word in the decisions you make?
- 12. Do you make more sacrifices for your own pursuit of pleasure than you do for God, His Church, and His Kingdom?
- 13. Are you more concerned over the status of our culture than you are the status of the Church?
- 14. Do you value the material over the spiritual, the temporal over the eternal, or self over Jesus and other people?
- 15. Are your identity, desires, dreams, and hopes more formed by Jesus or by the things of this world?
