#### Summer Family Adventures

Summertime is coming, so it's time to gear up for some awesome family fun! As your family travels near and far, use these amazingly fun family adventures to infuse faith into your journey.

## Family Adventure 1: Keep a Sheep

Grab a cotton ball or (clean) crumpled tissue and make it your family's pet sheep for the week. Give it a name and show it love. Wherever you go, take your sheep with you (sheep can't be left alone!) and make sure it stays safe and clean.

# Family Adventure 2: Lights Out!

Spend an evening in the dark. Turn off all the lights and find ways to have fun in the dark! For example, play an extra challenging game of hide-and-seek or hot-and-cold. Maybe tell jokes or funny stories, or sing songs together. The (night) sky's the limit!

Just before bed, turn the lights on and celebrate the power we have through the Holy Spirit. Just like the lights show us the things around us, the Holy Spirit's power can show us what we need to do!

### Family Adventure 3:

This is a great game for a road trip. Answer questions like the ones below. The catch? No one can use the words "I" or "me!"

- Tell about the most fun thing we've done as a family.
- Tell about the coolest place you've ever been.
- Talk about a silly dream you had.
- Tell about what you want to do when you grow up.
- Talk about a choice you've made.

Then read James 1:5: "If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking." Remember to turn to God, not "me" or "I" when you need wisdom!

### Family Adventure 4: (ross Roads

This family adventure can be done just about anywhere—in the car, at the beach, on a hike, or at home! Find items around you to make a cross, then take a picture of it. See how many crosses your family can make during the week, using different materials. Share your cross pictures on your social media page.

#### Family Adventure 5: P.R.A.Y. Every Day

Throughout the week, pray using this acronym. It will help you remember to watch for God everywhere you go!

Praise: Tell God what you love about him.

**R**epent: Tell God you're sorry for what you've done wrong and ask for his help to do better.

Ask God for something.

**Y**ay!: Celebrate God and all the things he has done for us.

P.R.A.Y. everywhere you go this week!

#### Family Adventure 6:

Have several family talent shows. One can be at home, where you'll have access to supplies such as soccer balls and instruments.

#### Family Adventure 7: Look Ma, No Eyes!
