### A note from Pastor Karla

November marks the beginning of the giving season here at the church. While God invites us to give ourselves to his purposes on a daily basis, it is also important that we set aside time (sacred time) to remember and commit to God's work in this world through his church. For Christ-followers, the decision to give is not primarily financial in nature. It is rooted in the nature of God and in our relationship with Him. The familiar verse of John 3:16 reminds that "God so loved the world that he gave..." This isn't simply a declaration, it isn't only a verse meant to lead people to Christ, nor is it simply a catch-phrase to be scrawled on poster boards for football games. This verse is a revelation that exposes the heart of God. It also gives meaning to our lives. If there is one thing the Bible teaches us it is that God is love and those of us who claim to follow him ought to love others as God has loved us. The message of John 3:16 is that love gives. This is the spiritual basis for Christian giving.

As we continue to live into our Divine Design this year as a church, and as we affirm that Divine Design in others let us acknowledge then the gifts of sacrifice and generosity which God has breathed into us. If we were to take an honest look at our lives, we will discover three inescapable truths. The first truth being that we belong to God and we have much to celebrate in that belonging. Part of that celebration includes being part of the family of faith. We are called to take care of that family. The second truth is that we have received much. While some of us may struggle more than others, the wealth of resources we have (time, talent, and treasure) far outweighs most of the world. In our season of giving we have the opportunity to take an inventory of our wealth and give thanks. And the final truth is that money matters. Jesus discussed money more than any other topic for a reason. Holding onto it too tightly, whether you have too much or too little, is what prevents our spiritual growth. We are invited to release for the sake of our souls.

May this time leading up to Advent be a time of joy and thanksgiving as we continue to exhibit our love of God through our love of one another.


### OCTOBER 2025 MEETING | JOHN SPAFFORD, CLERK

The Session welcomed Deacon Jen Moser, who presented the Deacon's Handbook with recent edits. The updated handbook was approved, and the Session offered a prayer of thanksgiving for Jen and the Deacons. After discussing helpful comments from a church member, the Session agreed to review the 2018 Emergency Plan.

Finance Lead Elder Amy Radonich led an extended discussion on church finances, considering impacts from Preschool changes, the renovation, seasonal expenses, trends in giving, and the careful control of expenses. The discussion closed with a prayer of gratitude that, despite complicated challenges, our church finances remain as Pastor Karla said, "in good shape."

A contract to install solar panels was reviewed, and the Session also reviewed the 2026 annual giving brochure. A proposal to print a new church directory was approved, and a new Discipleship Task Force, chaired by Elder Whitney Skala, was established.

### Holiday Traditions Online Event | Dec 15, 6:30pm




