Don't settle for little to no discussion just because it's uncomfortable! Lean on the Holy Spirit, pray before you start, and let God work through the conversation!

Leader insight: don't be afraid to re-direct the conversation! If your group is moving in a direction you aren't comfortable with, feel free to reign it in and re-focus the conversation. As always, your student pastors are available if something concerning comes up during your group time. They would be happy to help you navigate that.

Bible Verses

- 1 Corinthians 13:1, Song of Songs 8:4, Proverbs 14:12, 1 Corinthians 6:18

Discussion Questions

1. What did you think about the message today? What stood out to you? What's something you learned?
2. How does talking about the topic of sex make you feel? (Uncomfortable, awkward, fine, etc.) Do you think this is an important topic to talk about right now? Why or why not?
3. Have your parents talked to you about this before? What did they say?
4. How is sex viewed at your school? What do students your age think about it? Why do you think that is?
5. What are the benefits of waiting until marriage? Why is it important that we be patient with this area of our lives?
6. Read 1 Corinthians 6:18. What is sexual immorality?
7. What would patient, God honoring decisions about sex and sexual activity look like?
