What are we talking about this week:

Main Point of Message

- When you're treated unfairly, remember: God sees everything, and He calls us to respond differently than the world.

Bible Verses

- Proverbs 15:3, 19:11

Discussion Questions

1. Why does being treated unfairly feel so frustrating or painful?
2. Have you ever felt alone in a situation where you were treated unfairly? What happened?
3. What does it mean to you that God sees everything, even when others don't? How can this perspective help us when we are treated unfairly?
4. Why is it so tempting to "get even" when someone hurts you?
5. What do you think it looks like to "overlook a wrong"? When is that hard to do?
6. How does what Jesus did on the cross change the way we should respond when people treat us unfairly?

Now what:

Put it into practice: what's one thing you will do this week if you are treated unfairly? Here are some ideas to get you started.

- **Talk to God first.** "God, you saw what happened. Help me trust you and respond the right way."
- **Don't get even.** Instead of getting revenge, choose self-control, forgiveness, and love. That's what makes you different.
- **Talk to a trusted adult.** You don't have to handle unfair situations alone. Bring it to a parent, leader, or teacher who can help.
