Ensuring the Goals are Championed in Each Environment

- Train and develop prayer team leads around ways to exceed expectations as they lead and equip their teams.
- Affirm team leads with examples of exceeding expectations and challenge them in areas to improve.
- As a point person for the Prayer Team, be informed and distribute information about weekend updates, current and upcoming events, resources, and Eagle Brook policies and procedures.

Building Community

- Model and encourage interactions among volunteers so they can get to know, collaborate, and pray for each other.
- Email key information during the week and check in with team leads to answer any questions, give updates, and build connections.
- Always looking for opportunities to pray for the needs of staff, volunteers and guests.

Amazing Ways to Exceed People's Expectations

- Read books about prayer and share what you're learning with team leads.
- Know the ministries of Eagle Brook and be able to give a minute-long summary about each.
- Value team leads by knowing about them (e.g., roles they have in life, their passions), writing them a personal note, praying for them, and helping them take a next step in their faith.
