What's your life like:

- 1. What are some areas in life where people try hard to look good on the outside—at school, online, sports, or friendships?
- 2. Why do you think we care so much about what other people think of us?

What are we talking about this week:

Main Point of Message:

God cares more about your integrity than your image. Who you are when no one's watching matters most to him.

Bible Verses

 1 Samuel 16:7, Matthew 23:27-28, Proverbs 4:23, James 5:16

Discussion Questions

- 1. Why do you think it's easier to care about your image than your integrity? What are some examples of this pressure in your life?
- 2. The message talked about how people "paint over cracks" in their lives like the house story. What are some "cracks" students your age try to hide? What about you?
- 3. Read Matthew 23:27–28. Why do you think Jesus was so strong in his words toward the Pharisees? How does that warning apply to us today?
- 4. The message said, "God is a God of hide and seek. Every time we hide, He seeks." What does that say about God's character and love?
- 5. Why do you think confession is so freeing? (Read James 5:16 again.) What's one area of life you might need to stop hiding and bring into the light?
- 6. Read Proverbs 4:23. What are some ways you can go on the "offensive" and guard your heart this week-against temptation, comparison, or the wrong influences?
- 7. Integrity can be costly. What might it cost you to live with integrity in your school, team, or friend group? Why is it still worth it?

Now what:

- This week, don't just focus on looking good-focus on being real.
- Ask God to show you any cracks you've been trying to hide.
- Then take one step toward integrity: confess, ask for help, set a boundary, or guard your heart.

Because at the end of the day, God isn't impressed with your image—he cares about your integrity.
