 What is something in your life right now that feels stressful, scary, or out of control and how might remembering "God is not far away" change how you view it?
- 4. Mark shared how fear feels bigger when you feel alone.

 Can you think of a time when you felt alone in your struggles? How does knowing Jesus is with you and is stronger than anything you face, speak into that situation?
- 5. The message ended by talking about Jesus defeating sin and death so we don't face them alone. What questions or thoughts do you have about what it means to put your faith in Jesus or grow deeper in your relationship with Him this Christmas?
