What's your life like:

What are we talking about this week:

## Main Point of Message:

- God is Holy. He is other. He is unique. He is unmatched. He calls us to be Holy as He is Holy.

## Bible Verses

- Isaiah 6:1-6, Isaiah 7:14, 1 Peter 1:16

## Discussion Questions

1. Before tonight, what did the word "holy" mean to you? Has your understanding changed at all after the message?
2. In Isaiah 6, Isaiah feels unworthy in God's presence. Why do you think encountering God's holiness made him feel that way?
3. God doesn't push Isaiah away — He cleanses him and calls him. What does that show us about God's character and how He treats imperfect people?
4. The message said holiness isn't about perfection but about being set apart. What does living set apart mean to you? What's one area of your life where it's hardest to live set apart?
5. What is one practical choice you can make this week to live set apart for God? (At school, online, with friends, or at home.)

Now what:

This week, find moments to pause and worship God. Sit in the fact that we worship a Holy God, set apart, unlike any other. Praise and thank God that, because of Jesus, God doesn't push flawed and imperfect people like us away, he draws us closer to Him. Lastly, don't forget that God is the one who makes us holy, and we are to go live lives "set apart" from the world. So identify the areas of your life that are not holy and ask God to help you.
