## What's your life like:

Have you ever been blamed or judged for something that wasn't actually true? How did that experience affect the way you see fairness or authority?

## What are we talking about this week:

### Main Point of Message:

- God is just.

### Bible Verses

- Deuteronomy 32:3-4, Psalm 9:7-9, Romans 3:25-26, Revelation 21:4-5

### Discussion Questions

1. When you look at the world right now, social media, school, politics, culture, where do you see the biggest disagreements about what's "right" and "wrong"? Why do you think those disagreements exist?
2. The message claimed that without God, justice becomes subjective (based on feelings or opinions). Do you agree or disagree? Why? What problems happen when everyone gets to decide their own version of justice?
3. If injustice bothers you because it bothers God first, how should that shape the way Christians respond? What's the difference between seeking justice God's way and reacting out of anger or revenge?
4. The message ended with the idea that God will ultimately make all things right. How does that give you hope right now?

## Now what:

Micah 6:8 calls us to act justly, to love mercy, and walk humbly with God. What would that look like for you this week? Online, in friend groups, or at school?
