What are we talking about this week:

Main Point of Message:

- This week we looked at one of the most practical questions a follower of Jesus faces: is it actually worth it to share my faith? We live in a culture that can make talking about Jesus feel risky. It could cost you your comfort, your reputation, or a friendship. But, it could also surprise you. Philip's story in Acts 8 gives us three reasons why stepping out is worth it.

Bible Verses

- Acts 8:26-38 aloud together, taking turns.

Discussion Questions

1. When you imagine telling someone you're a Christian or trying to share your faith, what's the first feeling that comes up? Where do you think that comes from?
2. Philip got one instruction: go walk down a desert road. No explanation, no details. How do you respond when you feel a nudge to do something but don't know why?
3. Have you ever had what felt like a "divine appointment" – a conversation or encounter that seemed like more than a coincidence? What happened?
4. Philip wasn't a religious expert. He was just someone who knew Jesus and was willing to share it. What's one part of your story (before Jesus, meeting Jesus, or after Jesus) that you think could connect with someone?
5. What's one small step you could take this week to be more open to a moment like Philip had? It doesn't have to be a big conversation – it might just be being available.

Now what:

Write down the name of one person you're going to start praying for this week. Ask God to open the door and trust that He's already working in that person's life.
