

"I was created at the beginning of God's work, the first acts long ago. Ages ago I was set up, at the first, before the beginning of the earth. When there were no depths, I was brought forth, when there were no springs abounding with water. Before the mountains had been shaped, before the hills, I was brought forth, when God had not yet made earth and fields or the world's first bits of soil. When God established the heavens, I was there; when God drew a circle on the face of the deep, when God made firm the skies above, when God established the fountains of the deep, when God assigned to the sea its limit, so that the waters might not transgress Gods command, when God marked out the foundations of the earth, then I was beside God, like a master worker, and I was daily Gods delight, playing before God always, playing in Gods inhabited world and delighting in the human race."


