## Seasons of Life, Journeys of Faith

Antonio Vivaldi's *The Four Seasons* is one of the most iconic works in classical music, celebrated for its vivid portrayal of nature and its pioneering use of programmatic elements.

#### Here's a summary of the history:

The work consists of four violin concertos, each representing a season: Spring, Summer, Autumn, and Winter. Each concerto is divided into three movements (fast–slow–fast) and paired with a sonnet, possibly written by Vivaldi himself, describing the scenes and emotions of the season.

Vivaldi used musical motifs to depict natural sounds and scenes—chirping birds, thunderstorms, icy landscapes, and rustic dances—making it one of the earliest examples of program music, where the music tells a story or paints a picture.

This morning's performance will feature selected movements rather than the complete work. These excerpts are curated to serve as a musical meditation, offering the listener space for reflection following a spoken meditation. The intention is to create a contemplative atmosphere—one that invites stillness, introspection, and emotional resonance.
