JOHN 8:19-32

To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:31–32 (NKJV)

1.	Being true to yourself tries to define but offers only misleading
	It ultimately limits your understanding of the (vv. 19–22)
2.	Rejecting Jesus results in the reality of spiritual (v.23-24)
3.	"Be true to yourself" leads to and, pursuing fleeting
	desires without lasting fulfillment. (v.25; Ecc. 2:11; Ga. 6:8)
4.	"Be true to Christ" leads to spiritual and, pursuing
	biblical desires with lasting fulfillment. (v.31; Ga. 6:8)
5.	Without Jesus, truth is Knowing Jesus truth
	and grants true freedom. (v.32; Ps. 25:4-5)
6.	Foot washing highlights the difference betweenpromotion and the
	humble,honoring way of life Jesus invites us to. (John 13)
