RADICALLY BOLD: THE SOLID ROCK LIFE

matthew 7:15-29

*“The earth is the Lord’s, and all its fullness,  
The world and those who dwell therein.”* Psalm 24:1 (NKJV)

1. Don’t blindly trust the \_\_\_\_\_, check the \_\_\_\_\_. (vv.15-20)
2. Jesus isn’t looking for cheering \_\_\_\_\_. He calls bold, humble \_\_\_\_\_.  
(vv. 21-22)
3. Jesus isn’t just the center of your life—He’s Lord over every \_\_\_\_\_  
and every \_\_\_\_\_ corner of life too. (v.23; Psalm 24:1)
4. The storms will come. Both builders worked hard, but only one was a  
\_\_\_\_\_ of the Word, building on the Rock. His house stood, the other fell.  
(vv. 24-27; James 1:22)
5. Application: Don’t just \_\_\_\_\_ it, \_\_\_\_\_ it! Jesus’ words aren’t suggestions;  
they’re the solid foundation that roots and sustains you. (v.24)
  - Live the Beatitudes. (Matthew 5:1-12)
  - Pursue true righteousness. (Matthew 5:13-42)
  - Love your enemies. (Matthew 5:43-48)
  - Practice spiritual disciplines. (Matthew 6:1-24)
  - Trust God over worry. (Matthew 6:25-34)
  - Be humble and ask, seek, and knock. (Matthew 7:1-27)
6. Rooted and radical faith isn’t for history books, it’s for here and now.  
Go live it with the \_\_\_\_\_ Christ gives you. (v.28-29)
