1. Be assured: In 2025, Easter still breaks through a culture of absolute \_\_\_\_\_ and massive \_\_\_\_\_. (vv.1-3)
2. Until one \_\_\_\_\_, resurrection power is incomprehensible. (v.4)
3. Until one \_\_\_\_\_, resurrection truth is unbelievable. (v.5)
4. Until one \_\_\_\_\_ in \_\_\_\_\_, resurrection transformation is impossible. (v.6)
5. Until the radical resurrection is absolutely \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ, there is no “\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.” (v.6-7)
6. Wherever the resurrection of Jesus is celebrated, the takeaway for the church is:
  - a. There is no \_\_\_\_\_ to go and tell others that Jesus is risen! (v.8)
  - b. The stones have no need to shout praise because the \_\_\_\_\_ is already \_\_\_\_\_! (Lu. 19:40)
