A RIGHTEOUS GOD WOULD IMMEDIATELY  
DESTROY THE WICKED

July 20 | Jonah 4

Royal Meltdowns, Message 4 of 5



*“Then the Lord said, “Is it right for you to be angry?”* Jonah 4:4 (NKJV)

1. Nothing offends us and melts us down more than God giving grace to people we want \_\_\_\_\_. (vv. 1-3)
2. “Is it right for you to be angry?” God’s questions are meant to interrupt our meltdown and \_\_\_\_\_ our heart. (vv. 4,9)
3. Because Jonah loved his comfort more than lost people, God wrecked his idol and revealed a heart with no \_\_\_\_\_. (vv. 5-9)
4. God ends the book with a question meant for you. Do I really want God to destroy the wicked? Even though I’m \_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_. Pray and ask God:
  - a. Like Jonah, do I meltdown, isolate, and become a \_\_\_\_\_?
  - b. Who have I decided doesn’t deserve God’s \_\_\_\_\_?
  - c. Do I demand God’s justice for my enemies while \_\_\_\_\_ on God’s mercy and grace for myself and my people?
  - d. Against \_\_\_\_\_ am I melting down and angry... and is it right?
