OPENING LITURGY

P: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

P: How good and pleasant it is when God’s people live together in unity!

C: **It is like precious oil poured on the head and running down.**

P: We have been given the glory of Christ Jesus,

C: **That we may be one even as the Son and the Father are one.**

P: Merciful Father, You have called us to present our bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to You. Yet we confess that we often live for ourselves. We conform to the ways of this world rather than being transformed by the renewal of our minds.

P: Hear the good news! Jesus Christ was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification. He is our peace, who has broken down the dividing wall of hostility. By His grace, your sins are completely blotted out. Lift up your heads and know that you are reconciled to God and to one another. As your pastor, it is my great joy to forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

NEW TESTAMENT LESSON Hebrews 10:19-25 *[ESV]*

Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.
