Altar flowers are NOT ordered when Christmas decorations are on display.

Frequently Asks Questions:

How much do flowers cost each Sunday?

Each floral arrangement costs \$100.

Where will the flowers be placed?

The flowers will be placed on a flower stand on the brick wall behind the altar. It will be visible to those worshiping in person, as well those worshiping online.

Is my altar flower donation tax-deductible?

Yes, all altar flower donations are tax deductible and will be on your year-end statement from the church.

How far in advance do I need to schedule altar flowers?

Please submit your donation request at least two weeks prior to the date you would like the flowers to be displayed. This will give the church staff time to ensure your flowers are ordered and the dedication is published.

Will the flower dedication be published anywhere?

Yes, the dedication will be shown on our pre-service announcement reel and announced during prayers at all worship services on the weekend you choose. It will also be posted to our social media accounts.

How are flowers chosen?

The flowers chosen each week are dictated by the Liturgical Calendar. While specific flowers can be requested, their availability is subject to date requested. Altar flowers are meant to enhance, not distract from our worship or current season. The size of each arrangement is set to our space parameters.

Altar flowers are NOT displayed while Christmas decorations are on display.

What happens to the flowers after worship?

You are welcome to take the flowers with you OR leave them with the church to be used in other ways. If you choose to leave them with the church, we can rearrange them and distribute them to members who are sick, recovering, or celebrating a milestone.

What about flowers for funerals or weddings?

Flowers for weddings and funeral services are handled by our Church Office and arrangements are made during the planning of those services.
