## GREETING

Most merciful God, as the people of Jerusalem, with palms in their hands, gathered to greet Your dearly beloved Son when He came into His Holy City, grant that we may ever hail Him as our King and, when He comes again, may go forth to meet Him with trusting and steadfast hearts and follow Him in the way that leads to eternal life; through the same Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

#### HOLY GOSPEL John 12:12-19 [ESV]

The next day the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, crying out, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!" And Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written, "Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!"

His disciples did not understand these things at first, but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written about him and had been done to him. The crowd that had been with him when he called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead continued to bear witness. The reason why the crowd went to meet him was that they heard he had done this sign. So the Pharisees said to one another, "You see that you are gaining nothing. Look, the world has gone after him."

Search our hearts and minds that we may receive Your Word, share in Your Spirit, and be renewed in our relationships with You and with one another.

#### Moment of Silent Confession

- P: With humble hearts, let us pray together.
- C: Lord Jesus, the Father's only Son, the King of kings and Lord of lords, hear us as we pray.
- P: You reign over all things and yet humbled Yourself for our salvation.
- C: We confess that our rebellion against You in thought, word, and action is the reason why You entered into this world.
- P: It is why You passed through the gates of Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and why You laid down Your life upon Calvary's cross on Good Friday—
- C: to forgive our sins, to redeem our lives, and to cancel the debt we owe to God.
- P: With hearts that are humble and lives that are grateful, help us to receive Your grace and bow before You in worship,
- C: Confessing that You alone are Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Amen.
- P: Almighty God, our heavenly Father, shows His mercy to us in the sending of His only Son, the King of kings and Lord of lords. The One who entered into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday was handed over to death upon the cross so that we may be reconciled to the Father and granted His remission, full and free. We are justified by His grace alone. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

- P: Hosanna!
- C: Hosanna! Save us, we pray, O LORD!
- P: Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!
- C: We bless You from the house of the LORD.

- P: Open to me the gates of righteousness,
- C: that I may enter through them and give thanks to the LORD.
- P: This is the gate of the LORD;
- C: the righteous shall enter through it.
- P: I thank You that You have answered me
- C: and have become my salvation.
- P: The stone that the builders rejected
- **C:** has become the cornerstone.

- C: it is marvelous in our eyes.
