OPENING LITURGY

P: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

OPENING SENTENCES from Psalm 143

P: Hear my prayer, O Lord; give ear to my pleas for mercy!

C: In your faithfulness answer me, in your righteousness!

P: Enter not into judgement with your servant,

C: For no one living is righteous before you.

P: Answer me quickly, O Lord! My spirit fails!

C: Hide not your face from me, lest I be like those who go down to the pit.

P: Let me hear in the morning of your steadfast love, for in you I trust.

C: Make me know the way I should go, for to you I lift up my soul.

- P: Assured of God's great mercy, let us speak to our God as loving children speak to their loving father, confessing our sins unto Him:
- C: Lord of all, we confess that we have not gladly submitted to Your will. We grumble under Your commands, and we question Your purposes when they conflict with our own. We often follow our sinful nature, the world, and the devil rather than Your good and gracious will. Forgive us and teach us to delight in what pleases You.
- P: I ask you before God, who searches all hearts, and one another, is this your sincere confession?
- C: Yes, this is my sincere confession before God and before my brothers and sisters in Christ.
- P: Upon this your confession, I, by the virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen!

CATECHISM from Luther's Small Catechism

- P: As we continue to reflect upon the prayer Christ taught us to pray, we take time today to focus on the third petition: Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. What does this mean?
- C: The good and gracious will of God is done even without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may be done among us also.
- P: How is God's will done?
- C: God's will is done when He breaks and hinders every evil plan and purpose of the devil, the world, and our sinful nature, which do not want us to hallow God's name or let His kingdom come; and when He strengthens and keeps us firm in His Word and faith until we die. This is His good and gracious will.

NEW TESTAMENT LESSON Ephesians 6:10-18 [ESV]

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints.
