OPENING LITURGY

- P: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.
- P: As by a man came death,
- C: by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead.
- P: As in Adam all die,
- C: so also in Christ shall all be made alive.
- P: What is sown is perishable;
- C: what is raised is imperishable.
- P: God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with Him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.
- C: But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

- C: We have responded to them as they have dealt with us. We have not done to them as we wish they would have done to us. Forgive us, Father.
- P: "If you love those who love you, what benefit is that to you?" We confess our giving preference to people who are like us.
- C: We have loved those near and dear to us and have dealt with others without love and mercy. Forgive us, Lord Jesus.

- P: "Judge not, and you will not be judged." We confess our judgment of people we think are not up to the standards we think we can meet.
- C: We have failed to pass on the forgiveness we have received from You, O Holy Spirit. Forgive us, Lord our God. Amen.
- P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.
- P: In peace, let us pray to the Lord.
- C: Lord, have mercy.
- P: For peace shining down on us from above and for the salvation of all people, let us pray to the Lord.
- C: Lord, have mercy.
- P: For revealing Your Son to the world, let us pray to the Lord.
- C: Lord, have mercy.
- P: For peace so that the Church of God would more brightly shine the light of the Gospel in the nations of the world, let us pray to the Lord.
- C: Lord, have mercy.
- P: For all who join us here to thank God for the unsearchable riches of Christ, let us pray to the Lord.
- C: Lord, have mercy.
- P: Enlighten us, encourage us, and keep us in the true faith that leads to eternal life.

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON Genesis 45:3-15 [ESV]

And Joseph said to his brothers, "I am Joseph! Is my father still alive?" But his brothers could not answer him, for they were dismayed at his presence.

So Joseph said to his brothers, "Come near to me, please." And they came near. And he said, "I am your brother, Joseph, whom you sold into Egypt. And now do not be distressed or angry with yourselves because you sold me here, for God sent me before you to preserve life. For the famine has been in the land these two years, and there are yet five years in which there will be neither plowing nor harvest. And God sent me before you to preserve for you a remnant on earth, and to keep alive for you many survivors. So it was not you who sent me here, but God. He has made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house and ruler over all the land of Egypt. Hurry and go up to my father and say to him, 'Thus says your son Joseph, God has made me lord of all Egypt. Come down to me; do not tarry. You shall dwell in the land of Goshen, and you shall be near me, you and your children and your children's children, and your flocks, your herds, and all that you have. There I will provide for you, for there are yet five years of famine to come, so that you and your household, and all that you have, do not come to poverty.' And now your eyes see, and the eyes of my brother Benjamin see, that it is my mouth that speaks to you. You must tell my father of all my honor in Egypt, and of all that you have seen.
