OPENING HYMN "Once in Royal David's City"

OPENING LITURGY

- P: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.
- P: "Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good.
- C: His steadfast love endures forever."
- P: "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son,
- C: And will call him Emmanuel."
- P: In past weeks, we lit the candles of HOPE, PEACE, and JOY. Today, we light the candle of LOVE as we celebrate our King who came to us in humility.
- C: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."
- P: "In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him." "God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
- C: "So we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him."
- P: "See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are."
- C: Amen.

RESPONSE "O Come, O Come Emmanuel"

- P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- C: But if we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

[Moment of silent confession]

- P: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son,
- C: That whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.
- P: The love that we have in Christ is the greatest love of all. Knowing we are loved gives us confidence to come together in a shared confession of sins, with the firm knowledge that we will be forgiven of those sins. We confess together:
- C: We have sinned and fallen short of Your glory. We are unworthy of Your grace. Savior of the nations, come. Make our hearts your home. Abide with us, our Lord Emmanuel.
- P: Christ came to earth to save you. He died for your sins. "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.
- P: Your steadfast love, O LORD, extends to the heavens, Your faithfulness to the clouds.
- C: Your righteousness is like the mountains of God; Your judgments are like the great deep; man and beast You save, O LORD.
- P: How precious is Your steadfast love, O God! The children of mankind take refuge in the shadow of Your wings.
- C: They feast on the abundance of Your house, and You give them drink from the river of Your delights.
- P: For with You is the fountain of life; in Your light do we see light.
- C: Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON Micah 5:1-5 [ESV]

HOLY GOSPEL Luke 2:8-20 [ESV]

P: Alleluia! I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people.

C: For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior. Alleluia!

P: The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke:

C: Glory to You, O Lord!

And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with great fear. And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger." And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying,
