	<ul> <li>8 Prophecies Fulfilled in Christ:</li> <li>The time of His birth (Daniel 8 &amp; 9)</li> <li>He would be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2)</li> <li>He would be born of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14)</li> <li>He would be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver (Zechariah 11:12)</li> <li>He would be mocked (Psalm 22:7,8)</li> <li>He would be crucified (John 3:14)</li> <li>He would be pierced (Psalms 22:16)</li> <li>He would die with the wicked, but He would be buried with the rich (Isaiah 53:9)</li> </ul>
