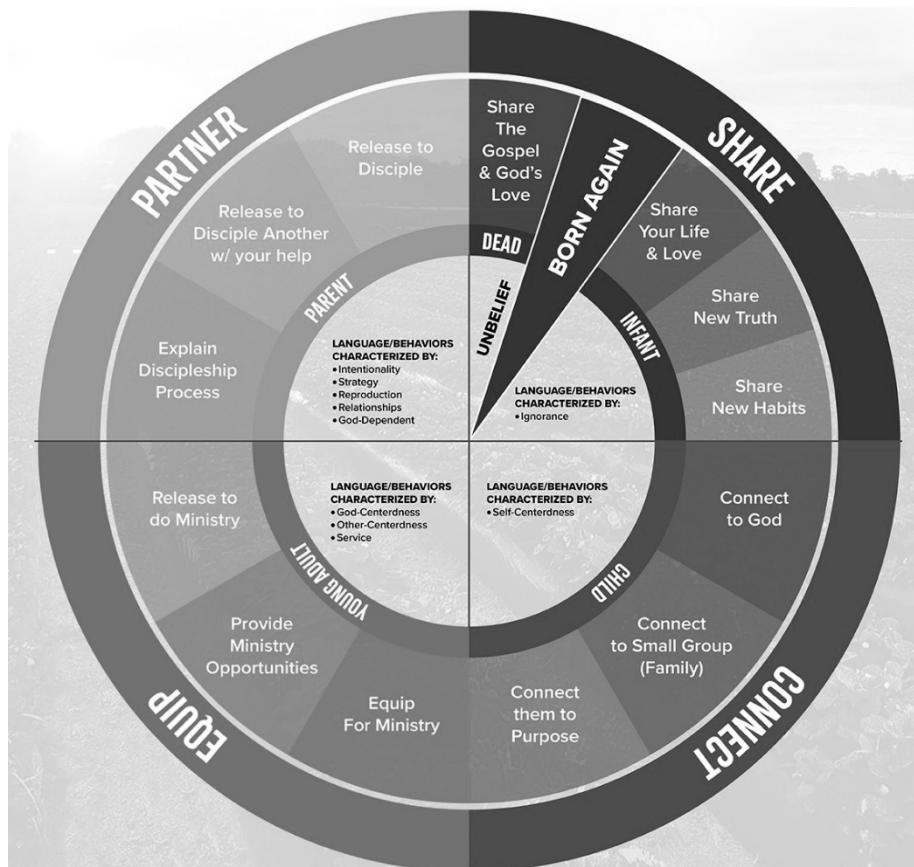
Are you IN-OR-OUT?

2. True disciples follow Jesus

Signs that “the Kingdom is at hand” in Mark up to this point

Mark 1:9-13	Affirmed by God the Father, empowered by God the Holy Spirit, defeating Satan in the wilderness	Jesus, the Son of God, has divine power to triumph over evil; he is without sin
Mark 1:21-28	Casting out demons	Jesus is “the Holy One of God” who delivers people from the Evil One
Mark 1:40-45	Healing (and touching) lepers	Jesus is the compassionate healer of diseases
Mark 2:1-12	Forgiving sin	Jesus is the Savior sent to forgive people of their sins
Mark 2:13-17	Calling a tax collector & hanging out with sinners	Jesus is the friend of sinners who came to heal sin-sickness
Mark 2:18 – 3:6	Correcting Sabbath practices to emphasize meeting needs and doing good	Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath
