


Are you IN-OR-OUT?

Signs that “the Kingdom is at hand” in Mark up to this point

|-----------------|---|---|
| Mark 1:9-13 | Affirmed by God the Father, empowered by God the Holy Spirit, defeating Satan in the wilderness | Jesus, the Son of God, has divine power to triumph over evil; he is without sin |
| Mark 1:21-28 | Casting out demons | Jesus is “the Holy One of God” who delivers people from the Evil One |
| Mark 1:40-45 | Healing (and touching) lepers | Jesus is the compassionate healer of diseases |
| Mark 2:1-12 | Forgiving sin | Jesus is the Savior sent to forgive people of their sins |
| Mark 2:13-17 | Calling a tax collector & hanging out with sinners | Jesus is the friend of sinners who came to heal sin-sickness |
| Mark 2:18 – 3:6 | Correcting Sabbath practices to emphasize meeting needs and doing good | Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath |
