Our Guest Speaker shared with us “Four reasons to give your all to Jesus.” Because I know him, I can say that this is his life purpose, his lifestyle, and his life passion. He is calling us to what God has revealed is most important, most rewarding, and most difficult.

In the following notes, I will try to represent the essence of his message by sharing what I heard and adding a few questions and Scriptures. I pray that what we heard (if you got to hear) and our discussions would encourage us to love and follow Jesus.

### **“Four Reasons to Give Your All to Jesus and the Lost”**

#### **Reason # 1-Because of the glory of Jesus.**

Our speaker reminded us that there is none like Jesus. Read the following verses and summarize what we learn about Jesus in these few verses:

### **Reason # 2- Because of the love of God for humanity**

- What do we know about God's love for every person in the world?
- How much did Paul love the Jews according to Romans 9:1-4a?

Our speaker shared a dream he had regarding 40 people in heaven. What does his dream mean? How was this significant in his life?

### **Reason #3- Because of the mission of the Holy Spirit**

- What is a key mission of the Holy Spirit? See John 16:13-14
- What do we learn about the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives? See Luke 24:46-49 and 2 Corinthians 3:17-18

### **Reason #4- Because of the commission of Jesus to go and make disciples**

- What was Jesus' summary of our mission? Matthew 28:18-20 and John 20:21
- Our speaker's definition of a "disciple": A disciple beholds Jesus, makes him the king of their life and welcomes others to do the same."

**Stories of God at work:** The Father is seeking worshippers who will worship Him in spirit and in truth. "Jesus' miracles were show and tell." The following are bits and pieces of stories that our speaker shared. If you heard the stories, **please share and discuss** them and consider why the speaker shared them.

- Avi's story of a visit from Jesus: "From now on, I am your father." Resurrection of sister.
- Another person had a visit from Jesus: From now on I am your shepherd.
- A person in jail was reading the Bible – "I am with you."
- Rachel in Uganda. Hiked up mountains to share with widows. "Tell us about Jesus."
- Itshemar (?) - pray and I will be healed. Many were healed including legs, blindness
